High-profile Stockport Metro names include James Goddard and Lauren Quigley, four times Commonwealth silver Medalist in Glasgow 2014.

On Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March from 4-6pm Stockport Metro Head Coach, Richard Blackshaw and Assistant Coach, Stuart Sant, will be at Copley to coach *just* Stalybridge swimmers. If you would like your child to benefit from their formula for success, then this is a superb opportunity. They can:

- Improve their stroke technique
- Raise their expectations and ambitions
- Learn about what it takes to be a top level swimmer
- Ask questions about anything from drill practices to nutrition advice.

As parents, this allows you to find out about:

- Session times for swimmers of your child's age and ability level
- Contact information and new swimmer trials
- And to speak in person to these coaches.

We want as many Stalybridge swimmers in the pool on Saturday as possible, no matter what their age or ability, as all six lanes will be coached for the full two hours if swimmers wish to stay the whole time, so please try to make it for this event. Admission is at the usual rate on the desk – there is no extra charge.
